Compass Box Hedonism 43% - £8.10
Vatted Grain Whisky. Very delicate, yet complex whisky with notes of nuts and honey with a balancing creaminess

Dalwhinnie 15 43% - Highland - £5.60
A touch of smoke accompanies peach, honey and oak on the nose. Vanilla, malt, and almonds take over on the tongue as the medium-long finish holds almond and vanilla with the subtle addition of butter-scotch.

Talisker 10 Single Malt 45.8% - Isle of Skye - £4.55
Thick smokiness initially shrouds sweet pear and apple along with subtle maritime salt. Peat dances with black pepper and dry barley as orchard fruits rises to balance the flavour with the addition of water. A long finish, smokiness and a dry warmth make for a very inviting sip.
